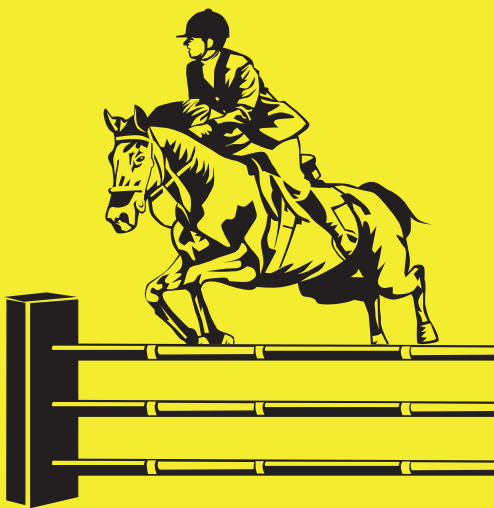

REGULATIONS

1. Entry Fees unless otherwise stated are \$3.00 per class, tickets are available from the caravan on the days of the show. Competitors are required to complete the form at the van, nominating horse and rider.
2. A limited number of loose boxes are available for horses at the showgrounds. Boxes must be cleaned out when vacating. Fee \$10.00 per night. **Straw is available for a designated fee upon request. Fees to be forwarded to Chief Steward, Geoff Kendell, phone 0428449923 Email: geoffkendell@gmail.com**
3. All competing ponies and horses must be measured before 10am on the morning of exhibition. Current Kerang Ag. Society or RASV or EA or VAS LTD or SHCV measuring tickets will be accepted. All horses must be bitted to be measured.
4. All colts and stallions 2 years and over must be led with a bit in the mouth by an adult.
5. Stallions are permitted in Stallion classes only, unless otherwise stated.
6. All events will be conducted in accordance with the current EA "Saddle Horse, Judges and Competitors Rules."
7. The Committee reserves the right to alter, add or delete from the program as circumstances dictate.
8. The Kerang & District Agricultural Society accepts no responsibility for any injury, damage or loss sustained by any competitor, spectator, animal or equipment.
9. The Judge's decision in all cases shall be final.
10. INTERMEDIATE: Not to have won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize singularly at any Australian Royal Show.
11. ELEMENTARY: Won a novice class but not won an open class.
12. PRIZES: **Prize ribbons will be awarded** to third placing, except where stated otherwise. Respective class winners eligible for Champion & Reserve. Sashes for Champion & Reserve place.
13. All rings to start at stated times, or events may be cancelled.
14. Random swabbing may take place.
15. Showjumpers may ride in more than 2 classes at the judge's discretion.
17. **Breeding Date:** Is from the 1st of August each year.
18. It is up to the competitors to choose which class they would like to compete in as rings will not be held up at the time of judging

OFF THE TRACK SERIES –

Qualifiers Regulations.

‘Racing Victoria has announced a change to the classification of its OTT program. Effective from the 1 August, any horse bred to race that has been Stud Book-registered, either domestically with the Australia Stud Book or internationally, will be eligible to compete in OTT events in Victoria.’

1. Open to Thoroughbreds unraced or raced 4 years and over, over 14.2 hands and registered with Racing Information Services Australia. Registrations will be checked.
2. Racing/Trial name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name, and the following details (if known). Racing name; Brands, color and markings, Microchip number; Life number; Registration Certificate number; Dam and Sire; Date horse retired.
3. Qualifying Shows must be affiliated with VAS Ltd.
4. Qualifying classes will be judged ridden.
5. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete in other qualifiers.
6. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Off The Track series Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships .
7. Riders to be 14 years and over on day of qualifying show.
8. To be judged as a good example of Thoroughbreds rather than riding horse/hunter types with the following being taken into consideration - Thoroughbred qualities - Conformation - Manners, paces and performance. Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed.
9. Judges decision is final in qualifying and final.
10. Qualifier prize \$50 sash, card and Racing Victoria Prize Pack (Prize Packs will be presented at VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championship)

1. Open to all purebred freeze branded Standardbreds registered with Harness Racing Australia. Raced or unraced. Registrations will be verified.
2. Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number must be provided.
3. Horse or Exhibitor do not need to be registered with any other Association or Breed Society other than Harness Racing Australia to be eligible to compete.
4. Riders to be aged 12 years and over on the day of the Qualifying Show.
5. Colts/Stallions are not permitted to contest a series qualifier.
6. Qualifying Shows must be VAS Ltd affiliated.
7. Qualifying classes will be judged ridden.
8. Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete at another Show qualifier in that calendar year.
9. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Alabar HERO Series Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
10. To be judged as a good example of a Standardbred rather than a riding horse/hunter type with the following being taken into consideration: • Standardbred qualities • Conformation • Manners, paces and performance • Racing related injuries and/or blemishes are permitted
11. The Judge's Decision is Final in the Qualifiers and State Final.
12. Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50.00 Prizemoney sent out once qualification has been verified and HERO Gift Pack (Prize Pack collected at State Final).
